

# A BRIEF HISTORY OF THE TRIUMPH MARQUE

Siegfried Bettman set out to build and sell bicycles in about 1885. He offered his first motorcycle for sale in 1902, having a 2.25HP motor. It was a Triumph. The Triumph name has been on motor cars since 1923 and after many financial problems, the company was purchased by the Standard Company in 1945. A Triumph sports car was introduced in 1952 to compete with MG and Jaguar. This led to much success and a range of sports cars from the TR 2 to the modern wedge shaped TR 7, having a 2 liter overhead cam 4 cylinder engine, and the TR 8 having a 3.5 liter aluminum V-8 engine. Spitfires, derived from the Herald chassis, were also popular, and claim the record for the highest production volume Triumphs.

In addition to sports cars, the Standard-Triumph Company built economical small cars, such as the Standard 8 and 10, the Herald and TR 1300. It also built larger saloons and estate wagons such as the TR 2000 and 2.5. Grand Touring cars such as the GT-6, and the luxurious Stag with its integrated roll bar and full fold down top or metal convertible hard top with a unique 3 liter single overhead cam aluminum head V8.

Standard Triumph was in turn swallowed up by what became British Leyland Motor Company, and by 1981, the marque was put to pasture with the last production Triumph rolling off the line in October.

Today, the marque is owned by BMW through its acquisition of Rover. Rumors abound that the marque will be resurrected. For us, however, the old cars are the best.
